To whom it may concern;

On Thursday, May 12, 2016 at shortly after 11:00 am, I observed the following:

A man was unloading what appeared to be cases containing jugs of milk at a residence located at [REDACTED] in the southwest Austin neighborhood of Travis Country. People were parking on the street and going up to the front yard and walking away with these jugs of milk.

Based on what I found on Nextdoor Travis Country - a social networking site (see blog post below), this is probably the residence of [REDACTED] and it is probably a location where [REDACTED] sells and/or distributes raw milk and milk products to consumers.

Since this occurred on May 12, the blog post would seem to indicate that the next raw milk sale at this location will occur at around 11:00 am on Thursday May 26.

The attached photos were taken at the time of the observation from the street in front of the address at [REDACTED]

Looking at the current DSHS website (below), it would appear that [REDACTED] still in violation of TAC §217.32 and appropriate action should be taken. It would also appear that the owner of residence where this is taking place may be in violation of local city and/or county codes. So, if you would also refer this complaint to the appropriate Austin/Travis County HD office that would be greatly appreciated.

<u>CHAPTER 217</u>	MILK AND DAIRY
<u>SUBCHAPTER B</u>	GRADE A RAW FOR RETAIL MILK AND MILK PRODUCTS
<u>RULE §217.32</u>	Selling of Raw Milk to the Consumer

Raw milk may be sold by the milk producer directly to the consumer only at the point of production, i.e., at the farm, provided that such producer has been issued a Grade A Raw for Retail Milk Permit in accordance with §217.91 of this title (relating to Permits), and complies with all the sections in this chapter relating to Grade A Raw for Retail Milk.
